<u>Location:</u>	PEDDIE SCHOOL 180 E. ETRA ROAD HIGHTSTOWN, NJ 08520 The Peddie School is located just off of exit 8 on the NJ Turnpike at 201 South Main Street, Hightstown, NJ 08520. The Peddie School Aquatics Center resides in the school's athletic center located on campus. Entrance to the athletic center parking lot is from Etra Road.		
Facility Info:	The Aquatics Center features a state of the art indoor 8 lane 35 meter facility with moveable bulkhead. The pool can be set for 25 yard or 25 meter competitions with 4 or 5 lanes for warm up or warm down. Depth of the competition course runs 7 ft. The pool utilizes SR Smith starting blocks, with non-turbulent Kiefer lane lines, and a Colorado Timing System.

Entry Times:	New Jersey Swimming does not allow ‘NT’ or ‘No Time’ to be used as an entry time. All entry times must be in short course yards.
Relays:	Coaches must turn in relay cards prior to that relay swimming, listing correct swimmers names and correct order.
Swimmer Eligibility:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member of USA Swimming as provided in Article 302. All transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last attached competition. Swimmers must use an UN- (New Team Alpha Code) as their team affiliation. All Unattached swimmers must be listed on the team’s official waiver entry form. All swimmers must be listed on a team’s official entry form to be eligible to participate in this swim meet in any event(s), including relays. This is a closed invitational meet. Peddie will invite those teams it chooses.

<p>Host Club Responsibilities:</p>	<p>The host club responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The host club will provide a single timer in each lane throughout the meet. • The host club will have stopwatches available for volunteers helping to time. • The host club will e-mail all club entries back to the participating clubs. • The host club will create a warm-up schedule that will be fair and equal to all teams. This warm-up schedule will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 1 week before the meet. • The host club will create timing assignments that are fair and equitable with as many teams participating as possible. These timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 1 week before the meet.
<p>Participating Club Responsibilities:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be e-mailed to participating clubs 1 week prior to the meet. • Participating club parents must stay off the pool deck except for timing assignments. • Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible. List the club contact for club officials on the meet summary
<p>Coaches Eligibility:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All coaches “on the deck” must be currently registered coach members of USA Swimming. Verification can be in the form of a current USA Swimming membership card or Coaches Pass available thru the USA swimming Deck Pass App. • Coaches must show their USA swimming coaching card or Coaches Pass for entrance to facility. • All Coaches must have some form of USA coaching credential verification with them at all times.
<p>Officials:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Swimming officials from participating teams should contact the meet referee, Ed Fago efago@comcast.net with the sessions when they are able to help. • Current USA Swimming and NJS Swimming certification is required for all officials and the Meet Referee will check your cards. • All officials must wear the standard white and blue uniform. • Officials will be required to work the entire session and will receive free admission.
<p>Meet Format Waiver:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will be run in accordance with current USA Swimming Rules. • The host club has the right to change the format of the meet with the approval of the sanctioning Chairman and either the Age Group or Senior Chairman. These changes would be made for a more efficient swim meet for the swimmers and the host club. Reasons for these changes include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To allow more swimmers to swim. • To conform to facility capacity limits. • To condense the meet into smaller time frame. Some of the changes that can be made: 1) change estimated start times, 2) combine sessions and 3) limit the number of swimmers.
<p>Warm-up Procedures:</p>	<p>New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Warm-ups will be run under New Jersey Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. Warm-ups will include general warm-up lanes, sprint lanes, and pace lanes. • All swimmers are entitled to a fair and comparable warm-up. All teams MUST get the same opportunities for general warm-up lanes, sprint lanes, and pace lanes. • All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end of the pool. • Uniformed and designated meet marshals will monitor warm-ups. • All general warm-up lanes will swim in a counterclockwise direction. • The warm-up sessions will be two 30-minute warm-ups divided by teams. There will be designated sprint lanes the last 5 minutes of each warm-up session. • Warm-up schedules will be e-mailed and posted on the website 1 week prior to the start of the meet.
<p>Check-In:</p>	<p>All check-in sheets must be turned into the control table 30 minutes before the start of each session. Swimmers that are swimming will have a line through their name. Swimmers that are being scratched will have their names circled with a “SCR” next to the circle. Failure to follow this procedure may result in the swimmer(s) being scratched from the session.</p>

No Show Procedure:	<p>Accommodate the swimmer where possible: No penalty will be incurred for an unscratched swimmer who fails to report to the starting blocks for his/her scheduled event. However, the event will be counted toward the swimmer's maximum allowable swims for that day. The swimmer may be allowed to swim the event in a later heat or a subsequent event if the swimmer is at the starting end of the pool, ready to swim, and an open lane is available. However, the host club will not schedule an additional heat to accommodate the swimmer.</p>

USA-S Racing Start Certification Statement:	<p>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</p>		
Audio/Visual Recording Statement:	<p>Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</p>		
USA-S Deck Change Policy Statement:	<p>Deck Changes are prohibited.</p>		
USA-S Drone Policy Statement:	<p>Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</p>		
Meet Requirement Statement:	<p>In order to be eligible for the NJ Swimming Zone Championship Team or for NJ Swimming Athlete Travel Grants for Sectional and National level meets, NJ Swimming policy stipulates certain participation requirements. As a NJ Swimming approved meet, this meet does not count toward those participation requirements.</p>

Article 302.4 of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations

False Registration: An LSC may impose a fine of up to \$100 per event against a member coach or a member club's representative signing a document which indicates a swimmer is registered with USA Swimming for a meet when that swimmer is not properly registered or eligible to compete for that club. This will be enforced by the LSC and the LSC will be entitled to the fines imposed.
